Aerospace Education-Elective Courses for Juniors/Seniors: Aerospace I • Aerospace II



AEROSPACE I & II – A TWO-COURSE CURRICULUM THAT LEADS STUDENTS TO THE PRIVATE PILOT CERTIFICATE. CLASS SPACE IS LIMITED AND PROSPECTIVE STUDENTS ARE INDIVIDUALLY SELECTED BY AIR WING INSTRUCTORS.

AEROSPACE ELECTIVE COURSES:



The Marine Military Academy in conjunction with the Sabre Air Wing offers currently enrolled students two advanced courses. The Aerospace Electives provide the student with all the training necessary to receive their Private Pilot Certificate and

can be continued all the way through to Instrument, Commercial, Certified Flight Instructor and beyond!

Class space is limited. Each student is individually selected by the Air Wing instructors from a list of prospective candidates. Students must be 16 years old in order to solo and 17 to take a check ride. A prospective pilot must: Pass the FAA written exam, obtain a third class FAA medical certificate and successfully complete a private pilot flight check with an FAA-designated examiner. The course fee includes all of the materials required to complete each elective. *NOTE: FAA written test, medical exam and FAA flight examination are NOT included but can be arranged by the Air Wing staff upon request.*

The actual flight training syllabus consists of five program phases including aviation safety, theory and operation in preparation for the FAA written examination and flight checks which lead to the Private Pilot Certificate.

AEROSPACE I:

A two-semester ground school course providing the foundation for the FAA Private Pilot Knowledge Exam. Students are encouraged to sign up for flight training from the Sabre Air Wing to begin their journey to becoming a Private Pilot.

AEROSPACE II:

A hands-on flying course designated to prepare the student to pass the FAA check ride and verbal exam for the Private Pilot License. Forty flight hours are required, half of which must be dual instruction. Class registration fees do not include flight time and flight instruction which are billed separately and are available as a package through the Aviation Wing.

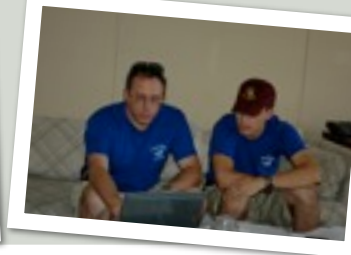
